In the summer of 2001 the Mid Year meeting will be held in Florida. Florida Department of Transportation has agreed to host the meeting. We will try to coordinate those dates with the Tribal Technical Assistance Program Meetings which are also held in July. They may be able to come to Florida.

We have two locations as possibilities for the mid year meetings for 2002. Bob Beardsley has volunteered to host the meetings through the Topeka Metropolitan Planning Organization in Kansas and Allyson Brooks may be willing to help with a mid year meeting as well. The decision for the next three years will be made this coming January 2000 at the committee meeting.

There will be a conference in the fall of 2000 addressing Native Americans, State Highway Agencies, and local government communications. Methods of Public involvement and case studies of successful interaction among States and Native Americans will be the foundation of the meetings with work shops to develop ideas for improvements and changes in the way we do business together.

The research efforts and direction of the committee was discussed. There are several publications being developed at this time. They include: 1) Best Practices in Public Education Using transportation Projects, 2) Florida DOT Survey, 3) Directory - Tom Eisnhour, 4) A Compilation of Papers on Transportation Archaeology - Julie Frances and Kevin Cunningham. Ideas for future efforts were discussed and several ideas came from the presentations at the summer meetings. They include but are not limited to: 1) Geo-archaeology: New Methods to Facilitate

Transportation Archaeology Work, 2) Public Participation in Section 106 on Transportation Projects - Robert Newbery and MaryAnn Naber, 3) Case Studies of NEPA/106 Integration, 4) Bridge Inventory Management Plans - Mary McMahon, 5) Cultural and Historic Landscapes - Becky Hawkins, 6) Competing Resources in NEPA - possible session in Pittsburgh and a publication. A poster session on Transportation Enhancements was recommended for a meeting in the near future.

Henry Ward and Myra Frank agreed to help plan sessions for the January 1999 meetings in Washington D.C. Henry volunteered to help involve the Aviation and Environment Task Force to due a joint session.

The Committee meeting adjourned at 2:30 pm.
